5 April – 30 July 2023
Hatred of the Clans. French Wars of Religion, 1559-1610

Questioning of royal power, fanaticism, diplomacy, intrigues: explore the dark side of the Renaissance. The exhibition convenes all the protagonists of this crisis: courtiers, men of state, ladies and captains, to retrace this frenetic turmoil that divided the kingdom of France from the accidental death of Henri II to the assassination of Henri IV, where civil war resorted to propaganda as well as weapons.

11 October 2023 – 28 January 2024
Victory!

Victory, trophies, glory... Do we really know the meaning behind these words we hear so often? At the crossroads of the military, artistic or sports fields, this exhibition will decipher the notion of victory from its materialisation to its valorisation, including its celebration, all the while evoking the rewards and fame of the victors. Enter History!

Located in the heart of the Hôtel National des Invalides, the Musée de l'Armée conserves one of the world's finest and most important collections of art and military history in the world. It's the ideal place to get to know more about the history of France.

Recognizable in the Parisian skyline by the gilding of its famous Dome, the Hôtel national des Invalides is a monument of exceptional architecture.

Created to host veterans and invalid soldiers, it is one of Louis XIV's greatest architectural achievements. At the heart of the site, the Dome has been, since 1861, the location of the monumental tomb of Napoleon Bonaparte.

Today, the Musée de l'Armée has undertaken large-scale extension and transformation programme to become, by 2023, the museum of France's world history from the angle of military life and war. True to its civic vocation, the Musée de l'Armée asserts its determination to provide all sectors of the public with the keys to understanding the state of the world and its evolution, making the connection between past, present and future.

There is no better immersion into French history than the discovery of personal objects of great character such as François I, Louis XIV, Napoleon I or Charles de Gaulle. With some 500 000 pieces the collections of the Musée de l'Armée cover a period from the Middle Ages to the 21st century: uniforms, weapons, armour, canons, vehicles, drawings, paintings, photographs, sculptures, archive documents and everyday objects.

Beyond the collections, the museum provides interactive displays to better understand the great battles that shaped History, particularly in the rooms dedicated to the Napoleonic wars, the two world wars and the historical Charles de Gaulle.

For a renewed experience, the museum also organises numerous events all year long: exhibitions, concerts, shows, guided tours or activities for children...
