Night opening until 9:00 p.m. on Tuesdays throughout April 1 to September 30. The Dome Church is open until 7:00 p.m. throughout July 1 to August 31; The Historial Charles de Gaulle is closed on Mondays

Admissions

Temporary exhibition ticket: 8 euros

Combined ticket: 11 euros

Temporary exhibition ticket at 2 euros on presentation of the ticket for permanent collections

Free Admission

Visitors under the age of 18, students over the age of 18, unemployed individuals and visitors receiving benefits (proof of entitlement must be dated within the last six months), disabled visitors and their helper, journalists, members of ICOM and ICOMOS, armed forces personnel (in uniform).
